

REGULATIONS

<u>GENERAL</u>: Para Alpine Ski Competition Rules, especially FIS World Cup Regulations, IWO FIS and those of the Organiser apply. Competitors registered by their respective national federation who are holders of a valid FIS licence are eligible to participate. The number of participants and access to the official competition areas is limited and is governed by FIS Para World Cup regulations.

<u>EVENT:</u> 2 x Slalom per women and men (Para category). FIS Codex: 0213 (27.2. M), 0214 (27.2. W), 0215 (28.2. M), 0216 (28.2. W).

<u>PRIZES / PRIZE MONEY</u>: Prizes: "K.S.C. Chamois" honorary trophy and a "non-cash prize" for ranks 1 to 5 per women / men per category. Starting gift. Prize money 1st place (\in 500), 2nd place (\in 300), 3rd place (\in 200) gross per women / men per category (please email NAME & account details IBAN to <u>andreas.salvenmoser@hahnenkamm.com</u>; valid only until end of March 2023).

<u>ENTRIES</u>: FIS Online Entry System. Entry deadline for number of participants (date 2023-02-13) and entry deadline for names (date 2023-02-20). Entry fees in accordance with IWO, accommodation and lift costs in accordance with ÖSV/FIS Info Sheet. Insurance of the participants is the responsibility of the respective federation.

OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD AND PROTESTS: Race Office Zielhaus (Finish Building) RedBull.

<u>CONTRACTUAL BASIS</u>: Ski racing is a dangerous sport. Requirements for the condition and safety measures of the racecourses are governed by the respective valid FIS Para Ski Competition Alpine Rules and Regulations as well as the instructions of the respective jury upon starting the race, participants declare that they have familiarised themselves with the condition of the racecourse, its facilities and boundaries and that they consider them to be adequate, especially with regard to safety. Each participant undertakes to submit any complaints to the jury. Participants are solely responsible for the proper condition of their racing equipment.
